Reduce, Re-use, Recycle

Curbside Recycling

Curbside recycling is picked up year-round on Tuesdays in Lakeside.

Inside Lakeside (Republic Services)

Recyclable materials accepted inside Lakeside (curbside, blue bins, waste transfer station)

Plastics: The only plastics accepted are “those containers with necks”. This is the same as “any bottle or jug with a threaded top,” e.g. beverage containers, dressing, condiment bottles, detergent jugs. Rinse, reattach caps.

Glass bottles and jars

Aluminum and steel cans

Paper: cardboard, cartons, junk mail, magazines, newspaper, office paper, boxes broken down

Outside Lakeside (Rumpke)

Aim to be Green Recycling Bins (acceptable plastics differ from inside Lakeside)

Location:

Danbury Township Police department parking lot

419 S. Bridge Road (SR 269 South)

Plastics:

Recycle bottles, jugs, fast food cups with lids, and tubs (cottage cheese, yogurt, butter, fruit etc.)

Rinse all and reattach caps/lids. Ignore the number code inside the recycling triangle.

All other “Aim to Be Green” accepted recyclables: same as inside Lakeside above

OSS Solid Waste District Hazardous Waste Collection

Household Hazardous Waste Collection will be held Oct. 10, 2026. Pre-registration is mandatory at www.recycleoss.org or call 419-334-7222. See acceptable hazardous waste items at www.recycleoss.org. We encourage Lakesiders to register and transport items on Oct. 10 to Ottawa County Fairgrounds, W. State Route 163, Oak Harbor

Leaf Pick-up

Curbside is scheduled in the spring and fall.

Check with the Association office or lakesideohio.com for dates.

Location: enter off Route 269 just south of dog park
